

Lesson Plan Example: Exploring Friendship and Teamwork with The Adventures of Dori, A Rescue Pup

This lesson plan can be customized to fit your class learning objectives.

Objective:

- Children will learn about the themes of friendship, teamwork, and compassion through the story of "The Adventures of Dori, A Rescue Pup."
- Children will engage in activities that promote collaboration, empathy, and understanding of the importance of helping others.

Age Group:

Preschool to Early Elementary (3-6 years old)

Materials Needed:

- Copy of "The Adventures of Dori, A Rescue Pup" book
- Drawing/coloring materials
- Craft supplies (paper, glue, scissors)
- Beach-themed toys (optional)
- Trash (simulated with paper or plastic items for cleanup activity)

Lesson Plan:

Introduction (15 minutes):

- Gather children in a circle and introduce the book "The Adventures of Dori, A Rescue Pup."
- 2. Show the book cover and ask children what they think the story might be about based on the cover illustration.
- 3. Explain that the story is about a pup named Dori and her friends who go on an adventure at the beach.

4. Discuss the themes of friendship, teamwork, and helping others.





Reading Time (15 minutes):

- 1. Read the book "The Adventures of Dori, A Rescue Pup" aloud to the children.
- 2. Encourage children to pay attention to Dori's actions and how she helps her friends and the starfish.
- 3. Pause at key moments to ask questions and engage the children in the story. For example:
 - "What do you think Dori is feeling?"
 - "Why do you think it's important for friends to help each other?"
 - "What would you do if you saw someone in trouble, like Dori did with the starfish?"

Discussion (10 minutes):

- 1. After reading, lead a discussion about the story:
 - Ask children to share their favorite parts of the story and why.
 - Discuss the importance of teamwork and helping others.
 - Talk about ways they can be good friends and help those in need.

Activity 1 - Friendship Bracelets (20 minutes):

- 1. Provide materials for making friendship bracelets (string, beads, etc.).
- 2. Explain that just like Dori and her friends, they can make friendship bracelets to give to someone special.
- 3. Encourage children to create their own bracelets, discussing who they would like to give it to and why.

Activity 2 - Beach Cleanup (20 minutes):

- 1. Create a "beach" area with simulated trash (paper or plastic items).
- 2. Explain that Dori and her friends cleaned up the beach in the story, and now it's their turn to help.
- 3. Provide small baskets or wagons for the children to collect the "trash" items.
- 4. Let children roam around the "beach" area, picking up trash and putting it in their baskets.



5. Discuss why it's important to keep beaches and oceans clean.

Activity 3 - Drawing and Coloring (15 minutes):

- 1. Provide drawing/coloring materials.
- 2. Ask children to draw their favorite scene from the book or create their own beach scene with Dori and her friends.
- 3. Encourage creativity and imagination as they draw and color.



Closing (5 minutes):

- 1. Gather the children together.
- 2. Ask each child to share one thing they learned from the story or the activities.
- 3. Reiterate the importance of friendship, teamwork, and helping others, just like Dori and her friends.
- 4. Encourage them to continue being kind and helpful to those around them.

Extension:

- If time allows, children can act out scenes from the book using puppets or costumes.
- Discuss other ways they can help the environment, such as recycling or conserving water.

This lesson plan integrates storytelling, discussion, hands-on activities, and creative expression to engage children in learning about friendship, teamwork, and compassion through The Adventures of Dori, A Rescue Pup.
